INSTITUTE BELL:

Theme: "The Garden".

1.A table runner made from patchwork and then quilted. Maximum size: 15"x 40" (38.1cm x101.6cm). Include suitable wadding in table runner construction. Embellishments/applique allowed if needed to compliment the overall design.

- **2. A tea cosy**. Knitted or crochet to produce a TRADITIONAL or NOVELTY design. To fit a tea pot of your choice. Any ply. Embellishments / accessories allowed.
- **3**. **A jam jar label**. Original design to fit A4 size paper. Materials can include paint, coloured pencils, felt/gel pens. No motifs, transfers, stickers etc. Entry displayed in a plastic sleeve for judging purposes Overall interpretation of the theme by the three items will be judged separately.

Notes from NEC that might be of help *Theme: The Garden*. This theme includes all types of gardens – flower, vegetable, fruit etc

Table runner: Quilting can be hand or machine. The size to be no larger than 15 x 40 inches.

Tea cosy: Pattern can be traditional or novelty. Make to fit your own teapot. Have fun.

A jam jar label: Work coloured design within A4 sizing. The label could be oval, circular, square or rectangular as a finished outline. Designs are submitted in a larger format for ease of judging to ascertain the overall features and effect. Do you want a generic look or a more specific type? Remember to allow space to record date and type.
